Dear School Nurse:

Enclosed you will find the 2011-2012 School Immunization Law Report. This report should be completed and returned to the Department of Health (DOH), Division of Immunizations (DOI) by October 15, 2011.

The DOI is continuing to collect antigen specific data for kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade students. The first section of the report is asking for the number of students in kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade that have the number of doses indicated of that specific antigen or had the disease. There are specific columns for specified vaccines; DT, Polio, MMR, HepB, Varicella (disease or vaccine), Tdap, Td, and MCV. Only record the students who are *current with their immunizations who are in kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade*. The grayed out blocks are not applicable for that particular grade.

Please complete the antigen specific section for kindergarten and 7<sup>th</sup> grade. The *Column* labeled *A* is the total number of students enrolled in that particular grade level. Of that total, how many of those students are medical exempt-*Column B*, religious exempt-*Column C*, or enrolled provisionally until they complete their required immunizations-*Column D*. Students who are denied admission or attendance because they do not have their required immunizations will be entered in *Column E*.
