


Deer-Resistant

Some Choice Woody Plants

Information was derived from numerous extension and other research reports throughout the United States and adapted for this area by surveying Pocono Master Gardeners. Deer-resistance is a relative term and will vary with the number of deer in an area, other food available, and time of year. Additional controls are recommended for areas with high deer populations.

* Indicates moderately resistant plants, others are very resistant.
