## AMENDMENT TO PROCLAMATION OF AUGUST 26, 2011

November 17, 2011

Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and due to the WHEREAS, on August 26, 2011, by Proclamation I declared an emergency disaster impending storms, rain and flooding that was expected to impact the

Proclamation of August 26, 2011; and WHEREAS, on September 16, 2011, I issued an Amendment to the emergency disaster

response and recovery efforts concerning these disaster conditions are ongoing. Proclamation have persisted and continue to cause adverse impacts to the community, and the WHEREAS, the threats and dangers associated with the original emergency disaster

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of Subsections 7301(c) and (f) of the Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa. C.S.A. Section 7101 et seq. as amended), I do hereby amend my Proclamation of August 26, 2011, as follows:

- 2011, through January 8, 2012. The period of the state of disaster emergency is extended from November 24,
- in full force and effect. 2. I hereby direct that the other provisions of the August 26, 2011, Proclamation, as amended by the Amendment to the Proclamation dated September 16, 2011, shall continue
