Hannah Penn Leadership Award Information

Objective

The objective of the PCW's Hannah Penn Award is to inspire leadership among women across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by proactively highlighting innovative approaches to mentoring. The recipient of the recognition is intended to be a role model, inspiration, and resource for women and organizations serving women.

Criteria

The award is established to recognize female residents of Pennsylvania who have been outstanding mentors and role models in the Commonwealth. The award honors women whose actions and accomplishments meet the following:

1. Demonstrated a commitment to furthering women and girls as leaders in Pennsylvania
2. Exhibit leadership and service in the community that has positively affected the lives of women
3. Lead efforts to improve women and/or girls well-being
4. Serve as a pro-active award recipient and engage in events in the Commonwealth to promote the ideals of the Hannah Penn Award

The Award will be presented in three categories:

1. Business Leadership
2. Civic & Volunteer Leadership
3. Rising Star (ages 16-29)
