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Treatment Manual Recovery Housing/ Case Coordination Update

In the 2010-2015 Grant Agreement, Treatment Manual, Section 6.04, Recovery Housing is being updated under the “Requirements” heading. The sixth Bullet Point “Be handicap accessible,” is being deleted.

Also, under Section 9.04, Adult Case Coordination under the “Requirements” heading, as well as Section 10.04, Adolescent Case Coordination under the “Requirements” heading, the following information will be added; “If the SCA chooses to provide additional activities or services, such as Intensive Case Management (ICM) or Resource Coordination (RC), clients cannot be required to participate in these services in order to be eligible to receive a specific level of care or type of service (e.g., Methadone, Buprenorphine). Additionally, the SCA cannot require that a specific population (e.g., pregnant women, criminal justice, adolescents) participate in ICM or RC in order to receive a specific level of care or type of service.”

These changes have been made in the Treatment Manual on the BDAP Communicator, and are effective immediately.
