Workers' Compensation Security Fund (WCSF) Catastrophic Loss Benefits Continuation Fund (AUTOCAT) Programs

All PACE Providers have been mailed packets of information inviting their participation as a pharmacy provider in the above mentioned Programs. Effective July 1, 2010 claims for the WCSF and AUTOCAT programs will be accepted using the PACE point-of-sale (POCAS) system.

- WCSF and AUTOCAT members are being mailed new ID cards.
- Claims submissions mirror PACE: the lesser of 100 units (tablets or capsules) or a 30 day supply.
- The NCPDP Workers' Compensation Segment is used for claim submission.
- Payment is made via EFT within 21 days of an approved claim.

Reimbursement formula is:

- the lesser of usual and customary charge or
- AWP minus 12% plus a \$4.00 dispensing fee* or
 - (*OTC's do not receive a dispensing fee)
- Federal Upper Limits (FUL) plus a \$4.00 dispensing fee.

- ▶ WCSF and AUTOCAT claims **do not** have a co-pay.
- ▶ WCSF and AUTOCAT are the **primary payers** for compensable claims.
