

**APPROVED CPR PROVIDERS FOR THE AUTHORIZATION
TO ADMINISTER INJECTABLE MEDICATIONS,
BIOLOGICALS AND IMMUNIZATIONS (Rev. 11/11)**

Effective June 22, 2011, pharmacists who wish to obtain or who currently hold the authorization to administer injectable medications, biologicals and immunizations must hold a current basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification issued by one of the following organizations:

1. American Heart Association
2. American Red Cross
3. American Safety & Health Institute
4. American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons and the American College of Emergency Physicians under the Emergency Care and Safety Institute (approved only for the adult CPR/AED course or the Professional Rescuer CPR course)
5. National Safety Council (approved only for the Standard First Aid, CPR and AED course or the BLS: Healthcare and Professional Rescuer CPR course)
6. EMS Safety Services (approved only for the CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer course)
7. ProTraining.com ProCPR Blended Program (Adult/Child/Infant CPR & AED Certification for Health Care Provider (BLS)) (approved only for this one program which must include **an in person skills evaluation**)
