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CAMBRIA COUNTY ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT AWARDED

Project Funded by American Recovery and Reinvestment Act

JOHNSTOWN - PennDOT District 9 today announced the award of another economic recovery project in south central Pennsylvania that is funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

PennDOT awarded Quaker Sales Corporation of Johnstown a \$5,189,288 design/build project to rehabilitate 4.5 miles of roadway on Route 219 from the Galleria Interchange to the Sidman Interchange in Richland Township, Cambria County.

The design work on this project is anticipated to begin this summer, with construction scheduled for later this year or in the spring of 2010. The work will consist of milling, bituminous overlay, guiderail and sign upgrades. This project will also include rock scaling along Route 56 and rockfall debris removal on Route 271.

Within District 9, PennDOT will invest approximately \$47 million of federal economic recovery funds on 17 transportation projects, which include road and bridge improvements and signal upgrades.
