### **Tentative Schedule Announced for 50<sup>th</sup> All-American Dairy Show**

**Harrisburg** – The 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of the All-American Dairy Show is set for Sept. 7-12, a week earlier than past shows, at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex and Expo Center in Harrisburg.

This golden jubilee features 22 shows in six days – including four full days dedicated to youth activities – and more than 2,500 animals shown by nearly 1,000 exhibitors from across the nation.

“The All-American Dairy Show has stood the test of time, and has grown into one of the leading national dairy shows, for adults and youth,” said Agriculture Secretary George Greig. “As always, high quality cattle will take center stage, along with a variety of special events and activities to celebrate this milestone anniversary.”

Several annual show events have shifted to different dates and times due to special celebratory activities.

The 10<sup>th</sup> annual Premier National Junior Events run in conjunction with the All-American Dairy Show from Sept. 7-9.
