## **Department of Health Introduces Free Monthly Immunization Clinic** *All Pennsylvanians Urged to Get Vaccinations*

**Harrisburg** – The Department of Health today announced the launch of a monthly public immunization clinic, occurring the third Friday of every month, at St. Paul's United Church of Christ, 47 S. White Oak St., Kutztown.

The clinics are by appointment only and will take place from 9-11 a.m., with the first clinic occurring Friday, June 21.

The department will distribute vaccines to those uninsured or underinsured adults and children who meet the eligibility requirements. All vaccines that are recommended by the Centers for Disease Control will be available.
